## Vivaldiana

Der etwas humorvoll wirkende Titel „Vivaldiana – Die vier Tageszeiten“ für zwei Trompeten und Orgel von Ernst-Thilo Kalke lässt die Interpreten und Konzertbesucher spontan an die „Die vier Jahreszeiten“ von Antonio Vivaldi denken. Eine Referenz an den großen italienischen Komponisten der Barockzeit mit den italienischen Satzbezeichnungen: La mattina - Mezzogiorno - La sera - La notte. Formal nimmt die Komposition melodisch-rhythmisiche Strukturen Antonio Vivaldis auf - doch bereits nach wenigen Takten wird dem Zuhörer bewusst, dass Ernst-Thilo Kalke diesem Werk seinen eigenen Personalstil eingehaucht hat.

Entstanden ist etwas vollkommen Neues: ein vierteiliger Zyklus, der als echte Bereicherung für die Besetzung zwei Trompeten und Orgel gelten darf.

Die Trompetenstimmen und der Orgelpart zeichnen sich durch musikantische Spielfreude und Gespür für die klanglichen Möglichkeiten der gewählten Instrumente aus.

Was die Interpretation betrifft, hat der Komponist sehr klare Vorstellungen, sodass der Ausgabe fein abgestufte dynamische Bezeichnungen und Tempovorstellungen hinzugefügt wurden. Das Werk stellt eine gelungene Repertoire-Erweiterung für die Besetzung zwei Trompeten und Orgel dar.

The slightly humorous title "Vivaldiana - The four times of day" for two trumpets and organ by Ernst-Thilo Kalke reminds spontaneously to the "Four Seasons" by Antonio Vivaldi. It is a reference to the great Italian Baroque composer with the Italian set names La mattina - Mezzogiorno - La sera - La notte. Formally the composition takes over melodic and rhythmic structures of Antonio Vivaldi but after a few bars the audience recognizes the very own personal style of Ernst-Thilo Kalke.

So something completely new came into being: a four part cycle which may be valid as an enrichment for the combination of two trumpets and organ.

The trumpet voices and the organ part are distinguished through its musical playfulness and sense of the sonic possibilities of the chosen instruments.

With regard to the interpretation, the composer has very clear ideas, so that fine-grained dynamics and tempo opinions were added to the edition.

The work represents a successful repertoire extension for the combination of two trumpets and organ.

Born 1924 in Stuttgart, the composer studied with Prof. Philip Mohler at the Musikhochschule Stuttgart. He wrote works for symphony orchestras, wind orchestras and chamber orchestra ensembles.

As composer and arranger he worked for the Erwin-Lehn-Big-Band of the Southern German Radio among others.
