Detailed description: This system contains measures 37 through 41. The Cor.1 and Cor.2 parts play a simple rhythmic pattern of quarter notes with rests. The Fl.1 and Fl.2 parts play a melodic line of eighth notes, with trills (tr) appearing in measures 39 and 40. The Bass part plays a bass line with some triplets and rests. Fingering numbers 6/4, 5/3, and 6/5 are indicated below the Bass staff.

Detailed description: This system shows the beginning of the Minuet in 3/4 time. The Corno 1 and Corno 2 parts are mostly silent. The Flauto trav. 1 and Flauto trav. 2 parts play a melodic line with trills. The Basso part plays a simple bass line. A fingering number 6 is indicated below the Bass staff in measure 3.
